

The British Council has set out below all the terms and conditions which relate to the "Education UK Exhibition voucher giveaway" competition. These terms and conditions are the competition rules ("rules") by entering the competition you will be deemed to have accepted the terms and conditions and to have agreed to be bound by them.

The competition starts on 10th of December 2009 and finishes at midnight UAE time on 15th of January 2010. We cannot accept any entries which reach us after midnight on 15th January UAE time.
